

I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

MINISTRY OF THE INTERIOR

1329 *Resolution of 20 January 2025, of the Directorate General of Traffic, establishing special traffic regulation measures for the year 2025.*

For reasons of road safety, mobility and traffic flow, in accordance with the dates on which massive movements of vehicles are expected, as well as the intrinsic danger of the load of certain vehicles, special traffic regulation measures are established, in accordance with the provisions of articles 5, paragraphs k), m) and n), 12 and 18 of the revised text of the Law on Traffic, Circulation of Motor Vehicles and Road Safety, approved by Royal Legislative Decree 6/2015, of 30 October, as well as Articles 37 and 39 of the General Traffic Regulations, approved by Royal Decree 1428/2003, of 21 November, and Article 14 of the General Vehicle Regulations, approved by Royal Decree 2822/1998, of 23 December, and the corresponding report issued by the High Council for Traffic, Road Safety and Sustainable Mobility, in accordance with the provisions of Article 8.5 paragraph d) of the revised text of the aforementioned Law on Traffic, Circulation of Motor Vehicles and Road Safety.

By virtue thereof, and in accordance with the competent bodies of the Ministries of the Interior and of Transport and Sustainable Mobility, for the interurban public roads and crossings referred to in paragraphs i) and k) of Article 5 of the aforementioned consolidated text,

The Director General of Traffic, resolves as follows:

First. *Movement restrictions.*

The following traffic restrictions are established, all of which are without prejudice to any temporary restrictions that may be imposed:

A) Sporting events, cycle rallies and other events.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 55 and Annex II of the General Traffic Regulations, no sporting event, competitive or otherwise, or any other event that may affect the flow of traffic or road safety, shall be authorised or reported favourably, especially involving exceptional use of the road and requiring escort by the Traffic Surveillance Forces of the Traffic Grouping of the Guardia Civil, during the days and hours indicated in Annex I of this resolution, as well as those using motorways, except in their essential connecting sections.

Exempt from the above are federated sporting events that count towards official international, national or regional competitions with the consideration of championships, cups or similar to these, provided that they are included in the sports calendar of the Directorate General of Traffic for those dates and places.

Likewise, in relation to the provisions of this section A), exceptionally, the Director General of Traffic, and where appropriate, by delegation, the Provincial Traffic Chiefs or the Deputy Director General of Mobility and Technology Management, depending on whether the event takes place entirely within an Autonomous Community or not, may authorise it to be held or give a favourable report to allow it to be held, provided that traffic safety can be guaranteed and there is no significant alteration to the flow of journeys planned at provincial, autonomous community or regional level, and that there is no significant alteration to the flow of journeys planned at provincial, autonomous community or autonomous community level.

national. The Traffic Management Centres in the affected area will be responsible determining the degree of importance of this fluidity of travel.

The authorisation or exceptionally favourable report of sporting events will require, in any case, that they are included in the sports calendar of the General Directorate of Traffic for the dates on which there are restrictions. Non-sporting events may also be reported favourably on an exceptional basis despite the fact that there is an alteration in the flow of journeys if there are reasons of social or traditional relevance that justify the public interest of the event and the impairment of this, provided that the safety of all road users is guaranteed.

In any case, they must be events that do not require escorts from the Guardia Civil's Traffic Surveillance Forces, or only a very limited number of escorts.

B) Goods transport vehicles.

It is forbidden to circulate on the roads monitored by the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters (Jefatura Central de Tráfico) of:

B.1 General merchandise.

To vehicles or combinations of vehicles with a maximum permissible mass (M.M.A.) or maximum combination mass (M.M.C.) of more than 7,500 kilograms:

B.1.1 By timetable and track sections. On the sections and during the days and hours indicated in Annex II of this resolution.

B.1.2 Exemptions. The following vehicles and combinations of vehicles of any maximum authorised mass are exempt from this prohibition:

- Transport of live cattle.
- Carriage of perishable goods, defined as those listed in Annex 3 of the International Agreement on the Carriage of Perishable Goods (ATP) as well as fresh fruit and vegetables, in vehicles meeting the definitions and standards set out in Annex 1 of the ATP. In any case, the perishable goods must account for at least half of the payload capacity of the vehicle or occupy half of the payload volume of the vehicle.
- Vehicles of Sociedad Estatal Correos y Telégrafos, Sociedad Anónima, for the transport of postal items within the scope of the universal postal service, from Monday to Friday, both included.
 - During the winter road campaign period, those transporting de-icing to ensure proper maintenance of road maintenance.
 - Public roadside assistance vehicles.

B.2 Dangerous goods.

Vehicles which are required to carry the orange danger marking placards required by the Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR):

B.2.1 By calendar and road sections. On the sections and during the days and hours indicated in Annex V (section 1 - Common Restrictions, and section 2 - Specific Restrictions section A) of this resolution, and in addition, when the vehicle exceeds 7,500 kilograms of maximum authorised mass (M.M.A.) or maximum combined mass (M.M.C.), those indicated in Annex II.

B.2.2 By itinerary. In accordance with article 5 of Royal Decree 97/2014, of 14 February, which regulates the transport of dangerous goods operations

The routes to be used by vehicles for the transport of dangerous goods by road in Spanish territory shall be:

- a) On journeys for distribution and delivery of dangerous goods to final recipients or consumers. The most suitable route shall be used, both in terms of road safety and traffic flow, travelling the shortest possible distance along conventional roads to the point of delivery of the goods. It is essential to use the ring roads, bypasses or ring roads outside the towns if there are any, and in the event of there being more than one, the most external to the town shall be used, being able to enter the town centre only to carry out loading and unloading operations, and always by the access closest to the point of delivery except for justified reasons of force majeure.
- b) In other types of journeys. If the points of origin and destination of the journey are included within the RIMP -Red de Itinerarios para Mercancías Peligrosas (Dangerous Goods Route Network)- which appears in Annex IV of this resolution, the vehicles transporting them must use them on their journey. If one or both of these points are outside the RIMP, journeys must be made on those roads that allow access to the network by the nearest entrance or exit in the direction of travel, in order to ensure that the route on single carriageway roads is as short as possible.

Transit on roads other than those indicated here shall require that the itinerary does not pass through crossings or that it does so through those of lesser danger, -in accordance with the intensity, classification and distribution of traffic, the size of the urban nucleus, the urban configuration, and the layout and regulation thereof-, and the layout and regulation of the same, and in addition, prior notification at least twenty-four hours in advance to the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area, who, in coordination with the Sector of the Traffic Grouping of the Civil Guard, will confirm whether the use of the new route is appropriate.

Likewise, it shall be permitted to leave the RIMP by the nearest exit for journeys whose destination or origin is the driver's usual residence; to take daily or weekly rest periods; to carry out vehicle repair or maintenance operations or to access the base of the transport undertaking, provided that, in all cases, the safety and security conditions laid down in the ADR are complied with.

- c) The provisions of the preceding paragraphs shall not apply when the carriage of this class of goods is carried in accordance with any of the exemptions contained in the ADR by reason of the cargo, quantity or type of carriage.

B.2.3 Exemptions. Vehicles carrying the substances referred to in Annex III to this Resolution are exempted from the prohibitions laid down in sections B.2.1 and B.2.2, under the conditions specified therein and without prejudice to compliance with any other restrictions which may apply to them.

B.3 Special purpose vehicles and vehicles requiring a supplementary registration certificate because their technical characteristics or the indivisible load carried exceed the maximum permissible masses or dimensions.

B.3.1 By timetable and road sections. On the sections and during the days and hours indicated in Annex II and Annex V (section 1 - Common Restrictions, and section 2 - Specific Restrictions, section B) of this resolution.

B.3.2 Exemptions:

- This restriction does not apply to vehicles which, because of their urgent use in fire prevention and extinguishing, environmental protection, maintenance of road conditions and saving human lives, must inevitably circulate during the restricted hours mentioned above.

To this end, at the time the journey begins, the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area shall be informed of the complementary authorisation number or, failing this, the vehicle registration number, as well as the emergency service to be carried out and the route to be followed from its origin to its destination.

– Agricultural machinery and construction or service machinery, provided that they do not require additional authorisation for circulation, shall be exempt from the restrictions set out in Annex V of this resolution.

– Special roadside assistance vehicles shall be exempt from the restrictions set out in Annex II and Annex V of this resolution.

– Lifting cranes with up to 5 axles (included) shall be exempt from the restrictions set out in Annex V (section 2.^º -Specific Restrictions section B) of this resolution.

– In the event of accidents requiring the urgent and immediate presence of automotive service machinery and lifting cranes at the site of the incident, they shall inform the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area of the complementary authorisation number or, failing this, the vehicle registration number, as well as the route they will follow from their origin to their destination.

C) Lanes reserved for certain types of vehicles.

C.1 Lanes reserved for the circulation of vehicles with high occupancy (VAO).

They are considered as such:

– Those belonging to the central carriageway of the A-6 motorway in the Community of Madrid, between kilometres 6 and 20, when the variable access signs to the central carriageway so stipulate.

– The right lanes of both directions of the road in the province of Granada, GR-3211 (from Granada (A-395) to La Zubia), between kilometres 0.115 to 1.410 in an increasing direction and between kilometres 0.105 to 1.530 in a decreasing direction, when the existing signposting so provides.

– The lanes belonging to the roadway of the Puente de la Señorita between the towns of Seville and Camas in the province of Seville.

– Those belonging to the province of Malaga, to the right lane of the exit branch towards Campillos from junction number 61 of the A-357 road and the right lane of the carriageway towards the Parque Tecnológico de Andalucía (P.T.A.) of the A-7056 road along its entire length, when the variable signposting so stipulates.

– The left lane of the Ma-19 dual carriageway between kilometre points 2.600 and 6.500 in a descending direction, access to the city of Palma (Mallorca-Illes Balears), when the infrastructure works are completed.

– The left lanes of both directions of the A-2 motorway in the province of Madrid, between kilometres 18.600 (Torrejón de Ardoz) to 4.300 (Madrid - junction with M-30) in decreasing direction, and between kilometres 6.100 (Madrid - junction with M-40) to 14.900 (Coslada/San Fernando de Henares) in increasing direction, when the existing signage so provides.

– The left lanes in both directions of the V-21 dual carriageway in the province of Valencia, between kilometres 10.101 (Albuixech) and 16.470 (Alboraya) in an increasing direction, and between kilometres 16.710 (Alboraya) and 10.390 (Albuixech) in a decreasing direction, when the existing signage so provides.

In all of them, the minimum number of occupants per vehicle shall be two, including the driver, and their use shall be limited to motorbikes with two or three wheels, passenger cars, buses with a maximum authorised mass exceeding 3,500 kilograms, articulated buses and adaptable mixed vehicles.

Consequently, their use by all other vehicles and combinations of vehicles, including passenger cars with trailers, cycles and mopeds, is prohibited.

However, they may also be used, even if only by their driver, by:

- The above vehicles do display the V-15 sign.
- By two or three-wheel motorbikes (motor tricycles with less than 600 millimetres distance between wheels on the same axle).
- For cars with a V-25 environmental sticker classified in the Vehicle Register of the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters as "0 emissions".
- For passenger cars with a V-25 environmental sticker classified in the Vehicle Register of the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters as "ECO", "C" or "C".

"B", only when this is indicated on the variable message panels for access to VAO lanes. In all cases, vehicles shall be identified by the sticker that has been configured for this purpose, placed in the lower right-hand corner of the windscreen, or in the absence of a windscreen, in a visible place.

The models of the stickers of the V-25 environmental sticker, and the characteristics of the vehicles included in the classification: "0 emissions",

"ECO", "C" and "B" are defined in Annexes II and XI of the General Vehicle Regulations.

- For buses with a maximum authorised mass exceeding 3,500 kilograms and articulated buses.
- For vehicles classified as taxis according to the criteria for use in Annex II of the General Vehicle Regulations, which have an exterior light module and a valid autotaxi licence, as well as a valid A-04 Taxi public service licence.

C.2 Lane reserved for public passenger service vehicles.

It is considered as such:

The lane belonging to the left-hand carriageway of the A-8065 road in the province of Seville, from San Juan de Aznalfarache to Seville.

It may only be used by vehicles displaying the V-9 sign.

Two or three-wheel motorbikes (motor tricycles with a wheelbase of less than 600 millimetres on the same axle) and mopeds may also be used.

D) Other regulatory measures in exceptional circumstances.

In order to achieve greater traffic flow and safety, in exceptional situations, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters, or where appropriate, the Authority Agents responsible for traffic surveillance and discipline, shall adopt the appropriate traffic regulation measures, among them:

D.1 Regulatory measures in exceptional circumstances.

D.1.1 Due to adverse weather conditions. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the circulation of certain types of vehicles may be restricted, without prejudice to the obligation incumbent on drivers of lorries with a maximum authorised mass (M.A.M.) of over 3,500 kg, buses, articulated buses and vehicle combinations, to drive on the right-hand lane of the road, and not to overtake or pass in the event of snow, ice, low visibility due to fog or strong wind.

Within the framework of the activation of a civil protection emergency plan, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters shall be informed of those actions determined by the plan's management body that may require some traffic regulation measure to be effective.

D.1.2 Due to high concentration of vehicles. Due to high concentration of vehicles in certain places of special protection, capacity constraints, etc.

of the carriageway, sporting and other events, as specified in the Annex.

VIII of this resolution, exceptional regulation measures may be established, which will be suitably signposted on the road and published on the website of the Directorate General of Traffic at least one month in advance.

Annex VIII referred to in the previous paragraph may be extended in the same cases by resolution of the Provincial Head of Traffic of the corresponding province and published on the website of the Directorate General of Traffic, when circumstances make it advisable for reasons of safety or traffic flow that require special traffic regulations.

D.2 Improving road safety on sections with a high accident rate.

D.2.1 Due to the characteristics of vehicles and road sections. In order to guarantee road safety, mobility and traffic flow, as well as due to the intrinsic danger of the load of certain vehicles, it is necessary to dictate restrictive measures affecting the circulation of certain vehicles or groups of vehicles transporting goods on the stretches of road listed in Annex VII of this Resolution, with the aim of reducing the accident rate and improving road safety for all users of the stretches in question.

For this reason, on a temporary basis until future specific actions can guarantee road safety for users, the proportion of heavy vehicles circulating on these sections is reduced, taking into account that there are alternative routes that should be used by vehicles affected by this restriction, as they have better route characteristics and greater capacity.

D.2.2 Exemptions. The following are exempted from this restriction:

- Vehicles or groups of vehicles in which the origin or destination of the goods they are carrying, according to the consignment note or equivalent documentation on board, are in the localities that can only be accessed from the restricted sections, in the minimum essential journey duly justified.

- Vehicles dedicated to the roadside assistance service which are in service.

- Vehicles or combinations of vehicles with special authorisation to circulate due to their indivisible load or their constructive characteristics, when their route includes all or part of the section affected by the restriction.

- Journeys within the restricted section, within the minimum essential distance, necessarily returning by the same route and with due justification: when the destination or origin is the usual residence of the driver or the place of domicile of the vehicle; when daily or weekly rest periods or compulsory breaks are to be taken; when vehicle repair or maintenance operations are to be carried out, or in cases of refuelling or resupplying.

- In exceptional, emergency or public service situations, the officers of the Authority responsible for traffic surveillance and discipline may permit the circulation of vehicles subject to the aforementioned restriction.

E) Restrictions on roads with a high number of cyclists.

In order to increase road safety and favour the coexistence of the different types of vehicles suitable for use on public roads, and taking into account the special vulnerability of cyclists compared to other motor vehicles with larger masses and dimensions, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters may set temporary speed limits on specific days and time periods on sections of interurban roads that are determined to have a high number of cyclists.

Speed limits shall be signposted by the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters, by means of the corresponding variable signage, or by the Body owning the road, by means of fixed signage indicating the full scope of the limit.

The website of the Dirección General de Tráfico will provide information on the stretches of road affected by these restrictions.

F) Restrictions on the execution of works.

Due to the special circumstances or characteristics of traffic, during the calendar of Traffic Operations on the occasion of the massive movements of vehicles planned during the year 2025, and with the aim of improving road safety and flow, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters will request, in any case, the Bodies owning the affected roads, to carry out the interruption of the works under the terms set out in Annex VI.

However, for justified reasons, the Bodies owning the roads may exceptionally authorise, after notifying the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters, through the Traffic Management Centre of the affected area, the carrying out of works on the dates and roads listed in Annex VI.

G) Prohibition of overtaking on certain road sections by transport vehicles.

In order to increase road safety and promote traffic flow, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters may establish, on specific days and at specific times, a ban on overtaking for vehicles over 7,500 kg of gross vehicle weight, vehicles requiring additional authorisation and special vehicles, on the dates and on the roads listed in Annex V, section 3 of this resolution.

In this respect, this prohibition on overtaking may be established on certain stretches of road for transport vehicles, other roads and stretches other than indicated in the aforementioned Annex V, section 3, as required by road safety conditions and traffic flow.

Overtaking prohibitions shall be signalled by the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters, by means of the corresponding variable signalling, or by the body owning the road, by means of fixed signalling indicating the full extent the overtaking prohibition.

H) Provision of lanes in the opposite direction to the usual on certain stretches of road.

For reasons of traffic flow on stretches of road susceptible to high traffic intensities and traffic jams, and in accordance with Article 41 of the General Traffic Regulations, approved by Royal Decree 1428/2003, of 21 November, lanes may be provided in the opposite direction to the usual on certain stretches of road to increase their road capacity. However, depending on traffic demand, these lanes may be provided in the opposite direction to the usual on different stretches of road to those indicated in Annex V, section 4 of this resolution.

Second. *Sanctioning regime.*

Failure to comply with the measures contemplated in this resolution that are considered an infraction in accordance with the provisions of the revised text of the Law on Traffic, Circulation of Motor Vehicles and Road Safety, shall be sanctioned in the manner provided for in the aforementioned regulation.

If the person obliged to do so fails to do so, the police officers responsible for traffic management may remove the vehicle from the road and deposit it in the

designated place, provided that it constitutes a danger or causes serious disturbances to the circulation of vehicles or pedestrians, in accordance with the provisions of article 105 of the revised text of the Law on Traffic, Circulation of Motor Vehicles and Road Safety.

Third. *Exceptional case of lifting of restrictions.*

Exceptionally, the Autonomous Body of the Central Traffic Headquarters, depending on the conditions under which traffic is being carried out, may allow traffic to circulate during the periods and for the vehicles affected by the restrictions established in this resolution, for which purpose it shall give the appropriate instructions to the Traffic Grouping of the Civil Guard and the appropriate dissemination of the measure.

Single final provision. *Entry into force and period of validity.*

This resolution will enter into force eight working days after its publication in the Official State Gazette. It shall be in force during the year 2025, being extended until the date of entry into force of the resolution establishing the special traffic regulation measures for the year 2026, with the exception of the restrictions for specific dates determined in Annexes I, II, V, VI and VIII of this resolution.

Restrictions on sporting events, cycle rallies and other road events

Paragraph 1. In the Autonomous Communities and provinces the following roads and dates:

Autonomous Community of Andalusia

Province of Almería

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - Friday 28 February, from 15:00 to 24:00.
- b) On the A-7, A-92, N-340a, N-341, N-344, A-332, A-352, A-370, AL-12, AL-3108, AL-3115, AL-3117, AL-4200, AL-5107 and AL-7107:
 - Every Friday, Saturday, Sunday and public holiday in July, August and September, from zero to twenty-four hours.

Province of Cádiz

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - From Friday 25 April at 15:00 to Sunday 27 April 24:00.
- b) On the N-4, N-340, N-351, A-314, A-383, A-390, A-396, A-471, A-491, A-2001, A-2075, A-2076, A-2077, A-2078, A-2079, A-2101, A-2102, A-2103, A-2227, A-2229, A-2230, A-2231, A-2232, A-2233, A-2325, CA-36, CA-3206, CA-3208 and CA-4202:
 - Every Friday, from Friday 27 June to Friday 5 September, from 15:00 to 24:00.

– Every Saturday, Sunday, public holiday and the eve of public holidays, from Saturday 28 June to Sunday 7 September, from zero to twenty-four hours.

Province of Cordoba

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
- b) On the A-4, A-45, CO-31, CO-32 and N-432 roads from Córdoba to border with the province of Badajoz:
 - Throughout the year, from 15.00 on Fridays to 24.00 on Sundays.
 - From Thursday 27 February at 15:00 to Sunday 2 March at 24:00.

Province of Granada

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - Friday 28 February, from zero to twenty-four hours.
- b) On the A-44, GR-30, N-340 and N-432 roads (Granada-Pinos Puente section, between kilometre points 419 and 438):
 - Every Friday, Saturday, Sunday, public holiday and the eve of public holidays July and August, from zero to twenty-four hours.

Province of Huelva

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
- b) On the A-483 road:
 - Sunday 26 January, from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
 - From Wednesday 4 June at 00:00 to Tuesday 10 June at 24:00.
- c) On the A-474 road:
 - Sunday 8 June, from zero to twenty-four hours.
- d) On roads N-431, N-442, A-483, A-497, A-5051, A-5052, A-5053, A-5054, A-5056 and A-5076:
 - Every Saturday, Sunday and public holiday, from Saturday 14 June to Sunday 7 September, from zero to twenty-four hours.

Province of Jaén

- a) On all roads in the province:
 - The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - Sunday 27 July, from 15:00 to 2400.
 - Monday 10 November, from midday to midnight.

- b) On the N-322, N-323 and A-316 roads:
- Every Friday, Saturday, Sunday, public holiday and the eve of public holidays July and August, from zero to twenty-four hours.
- c) On roads A-6177 and A-6178:
- From Friday 25 April at 00:00 to Monday 28 April 24:00.

Province of Malaga

- a) On all roads in the province:
- The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - Friday 28 February, from 15:00 to 24:00.
- b) On the A-7, AP-7 and MA-20 roads:
- Every day of the year, from zero to twenty-four hours.
- c) On the A-45, AP-46, N-340, A-92, A-92M, MA-24, A-357, A-355, A-397 and A-356:
- Every Friday, Saturday, Sunday, public holiday and the eve of public holidays, between Saturday 7 June and Sunday 29 June, from midnight to midnight.
 - Every day in July and August, from zero to twenty-four hours.
 - Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 September, from zero to twenty-four hours.

Province of Seville

- a) On all roads in the province:
- The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
- b) On the AP-4, A-49, A-66, A-8083, SE-40, SE-31 and SE-30 (road between kilometre points 0 to 22):
- Every day of the year, from eight to twenty-four hours.
- c) On roads A-8058 and A-8057:
- Throughout the year, from eight o'clock on Fridays to twenty-four o'clock on Sundays.

Autonomous Community of Aragon

Province of Huesca

- a) On all roads in the province:
- The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
 - Wednesday 23 April, from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
 - From Friday 8 August at 15:00 to Sunday 10 August 24:00.

Province of Teruel

a) On the State Road Network roads, and on the A-228 (between kilometre points 1 to 34), A-232 (between kilometre points 1 to 18) and A-1512 (between kilometre points 1 to 29):

- The dates listed in section 2 of this Annex I.
- b) On the roads of the State Road Network.
 - Wednesday 23 April, from 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
 - From Friday 6 June at 15:00 to Sunday 8 June at 15:00.
 - From Friday 11 July at 00:00 to Sunday 13 July at 24:00.

Province of Zaragoza

a) On all roads in the province:






